Mack Urban starts management firm

SEATTLE — Mack Urban has started a residential property management and leasing company called Mack Urban Communities.

The new company will manage properties in Seattle and southern California, two of Mack Urban's top markets. Mack Urban Communities is managing Kavela, a 63-unit complex in Roosevelt that opened last year, and Velo, a 165-unit project in Fremont that will open later this year.

Mack Urban hired Kathy Klingele as vice president of marketing and creative services and Jeff Cruz as vice president of operations. Klingele was with CIM Group and Kennedy Wilson. Cruz was a regional vice president at Winthrop Management.

Mack Urban formed last year as the West Coast affiliate of the Mack Real Estate Group. It combined the staffs of Harbor Urban and Urban Partners of Los Angeles.
